As I write this, it feels more like June outside than the cusp of November, but I'm not complaining. No snow is always good in my book. November is typically the time I like to focus on Thankfulness. At one church I was part of years ago, the pastor would challenge us to think of one thing we are thankful for per day in November, and then offer a prayer of thanksgiving for that person, group, or situation. At the top of the list for my thankful things

is you all. Daily I am thankful and humbled for the opportunity to serve as your Pastor and engage in Mission with you! You are passionate, you are flexible, you are deeply faithful and willing to engage in the tough questions, and for those things I am thankful. You push me, and stretch me almost as much as I do you, and for that also I am thankful. One of the things I am most thankful for this year is the opportunity for a time of sabbatical. I know there are a lot of questions still, and a little anxiety as well for this time that is to come. So, let me offer this quick update....

<u>DURATION-</u> I will begin my sabbatical on January 1 2025, and start transitioning back into the office and parish Mid July 2025

<u>PASTORAL COVERAGE</u>- is arranged. Pastor Deb Mechler will cover two Sundays a month, Pastor Jeff Gieger will cover one Sunday a month.. Plans for the other Sunday are still being worked on, but that one may be left open so we could invite groups that we have supported; like the Synod, Church of the Damascus Road, LSI and others to give presentations, or do a lay-led Sunday of some type. Pastoral care and visitation will be handled by my wife, Pastor Kris, who has contracted with the parish to do regular visits, pastoral emergencies, funerals and weddings etc.


<u>WHAT WILL I BE DOING-</u> Much of my time will be spent in Minneapolis at Augsburg University studying Leadership in times of change and transformation. At the end of April I will have completed a certificate in Leadership Studies. The rest of the time will be spent in reflection and relaxation, and some travel to visit family, help Jonah move, and see some sights around the country.

<u>FUNDING-</u> I have applied for numerous grants to help fund all of this. At this time I have not heard back from a couple of them, though I hope to hear soon. I will be paid a partial salary during the sabbatical time.

<u>WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM ME-</u> In return for this gift of time away, I will commit to at least a year upon my return, though truthfully we have no plans to go anywhere at this time.

<u>WHAT I NEED FROM YOU-</u> Two very simple things. Pray for me during this time away and pray for yourselves as well. <u>DON'T</u> stop coming to church! Continue to engage in the mission and worship of the parish. Enjoy hearing different voices. Take some time to engage and explore something new as a parish. God alone knows what we may discover.


