O Lord, how shall I meet you, how welcome you aright? (ELW #241)

We enter once again into the winter season, which also heralds the seasons of Advent and Christmas. We dive deeply once again into preparation, anticipation, wonder and mystery. For some, this is a joyous time. For others, not so much for a variety of reasons. The season comes, bringing with it One who meets us where we are. This is both the central mystery, and the central promise of our faith...

"The Word became flesh, and encamps in the midst of His people" (John 1)

At this end of history, we are somewhere in the middle; a liminal space where we remember and celebrate Christ's coming and all that comes with it, even as we join with the throngs of disciples who since that time, await His coming again. More often than not these spaces are not comfortable; they come with questions, doubts, fears, anxiety and a whole host of other feelings. At such times, it is easy to get discouraged; easy to yearn for restoration of our community of faith, and for ourselves. We yearn for solutions to those problems and challenges that vex us, draining our spirits. It is for times such as this that these liturgical seasons exist. The ancient texts, prayers and hymns call us to remember exactly where and in whom our hope lies. They also remind us again, because we tend to lose sight of it all too often; that the One for whom we yearn is still in our midst, moving and shaping the communities He calls into being, the individ-

uals He claims, and the world around us. The Hope spoken during these seasons is not an empty one, for it lies in the One who defeated death itself! The One who does not and will not forget His people! The One who Loves us!
