### STEWARDSHIP Let Your Thankfulness Show

#### Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances!--

#### 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

Sages, mystics and prophets through the ages have taught us that cultivating an attitude of thankfulness will not only help us grow as disciples, but thankfulness will also bring us closer to God and neighbor, and give us a happier and more fulfilling life.

And how do you cultivate thankfulness? First and always, through prayer. Consider how many of the Psalms offer thanks, or how often the Apostle Paul gives thanks for the people and blessings of his ministry. Pray always, and always with thanksgiving. Keep a "blessings list" and pray through it regularly. Giving thanks to God can nourish thankfulness in your own heart and soul. And you can also help encourage thankfulness in your community by developing a habit of thanking others - verbally, by text or email, or with cards and notes.

Throughout July, look for every opportunity to thank someone for any reason, big or small. It could be a stranger who holds a door open for you, a clerk who rings up your sale, or a neighbor who does you a favor. Keep track of the number of times you can say "thank you." In the process of saying "thank you" you will not only develop a habit that will change your heart and soul, you will also change your relationship with neighbors, your community and our world. And that will be a real cause for thanksgiving.
